What just happened?

It's all over the news. Thousands, maybe millions of people just vanished from all over the world. Some people are saying it couldn't have been the Rapture because there are still some Christians left. But it was. You know it was. Because the people in your life who are gone were all Christians, and believed in Jesus.

Know this. Your loved ones did not want to leave you behind! They so desperately wanted you to come with them. They wanted you to believe. They tried everything they knew to get you to believe in Jesus before it was too late, but they couldn't get through. They said everything they knew to say. They did everything they knew to do. They prayed for you every single day, often more than once a day. They wanted you to escape the tribulation that is coming and be with them in heaven. It's too late now to escape the tribulation, but it's not too late to get to heaven! You can still dedicate your life to Jesus and be saved. You can still live for God and go to heaven. It's going to be harder now. A lot harder. But it will only last a little while, and then you will be together with your loved ones in heaven, forever and ever. Seven years of tribulation will be bearable when it is followed by thousands and thousands of years in paradise. Just whatever you do, please, do not take the mark of the beast! Anyone who accepts the mark of the beast can not be saved and will spend eternity in torment, because it is an act of will against God, to choose the devil's side instead of choosing God's side.

The government will make it seem like you can't survive without the Mark. You won't be able to buy or sell without the Mark. But trust that God will provide for you. "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me." That verse is found in Philippians 4:13. Jesus promised that God will make possible what seems impossible. "But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible." ~ Matthew 19:26. In Mark 9:23 "Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth." The wisdom of Solomon in Proverbs 3:5-6 says, "Trust in the Lord with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths." You have seen that the rapture is true. Believe that the rest of the Bible is true also. Trust in God. Trust also in Jesus. Read the Bible, believe it, and follow it. God's word is the breath of life to you. Memorize as much of it as you can for the day when the authorities try to take Bibles away from people. They can't take away what you have memorized.

So what about the other people who say they are Christians but they didn't go? Who are they? Why are they still here?

The Bible talks about many false teachers will lead people astray. 2 Peter chapter 2 says, "But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction. And many shall follow their pernicious ways; by reason of whom the way of truth shall be evil spoken of. And through covetousness shall they with feigned words make merchandise of you: whose judgment now of a long time lingereth not, and their damnation slumbereth not." This means that there are pastors who have been preaching what the people want to hear instead of preaching the truth, and now all these people who thought they had a free ticket to heaven without any commitment to Jesus have all been left behind.

Some of them will know that they were left, and they will repent, and they will start living for Jesus now. Seek out these people and join them.

Some of them will insist that the rapture never happened, they will follow the world, and they will ultimately turn their hearts away from Jesus. Don't be like them, their path leads to eternal destruction in hell.

Again, be assured that you can still be saved! You can still go to heaven! You must believe in Jesus and make Him Lord of your life. That means you have to do what Jesus says to do instead of what the world says to do. You have to believe that He died for you so that you could live. You have to believe that He loved you so much that he sacrificed his life for you on the cross as the final sacrifice for your sins so that He could have a relationship with you for all eternity. You have to trust in Him. You have to trust that God is good and He wants the best for you, and He will take care of you. You have to understand that this life is not the end. That whatever happens here and now, is not all that there is. Your loved ones are waiting for you in Heaven and they are so very much hoping to see you in eternity. This is your last chance to choose between God and the devil, your last chance to choose between heaven and hell, your last chance to choose between eternal life and eternal death, your last chance to make right all the wrongs in your life and be reunited with everyone who loved you. Choose life, choose heaven, choose God. We want to see you again! No one can make the choice for you, it is yours alone to make. If your loved ones could have chosen for you, they would have taken you with them in an instant to spare you the terrible days to come.

After the rapture there will be 7 years of tribulation. The book of Revelations talks about what will happen during the tribulation, the signs to look for, and how long different trials will last, but references to the period of tribulation are all throughout the Bible. They can be found in the Old Testament books of Daniel and Isaiah and Joel, as well as references throughout the New Testament. Jesus talked about

it. The Apostles talked about it. Now the rapture has happened and the period of tribulation will come. There will be talks of peace, but ultimately it will end in war. There will be plagues, there will be earthquakes, there will be fires, there will be other natural disasters. There will be a global unifcation under a one world government. There will be intense pressure for every living person to be marked with the Mark of the Beast to signify their allegiance to this world government. Anyone who does not take the Mark will be killed, probably beheaded. It is better to be killed and enter heaven than to take the Mark and spend eternity in hell!!! Remember this! Do not take the Mark, it will mark you for eternal damnation and torment. They can take your life but they can not take your soul, not unless you give it to them. Don't be upset that they didn't pack one for you, maybe they felt like they weren't allowed to prepare and they were trying to honor your wishes. Thank Jesus that you have this booklet now to warn you so that you can prepare for the emergency situations to come. Thank the Lord for providing anything that He gives you right now to take care of your needs.

You might have noticed even before your loved ones vanished that the unrest in the world was increasing. You might have noticed that the number of natural and freak disasters were escalating. You might have noticed that sinfulness, hate, violence, crime, selfishness, and immoral behavior in the world was spreading faster than ever before and growing stronger. You might have noticed there were more lunar and eclipses than usual. You might have heard that the lunar eclipses, called blood moons, were all happening on Jewish feast days the last couple years which is very unusual. You might have heard about mysterious mass deaths of fishes and birds and other creatures. These were all warning signs that the rapture was going to happen soon, that the end of days was coming. The end of days is here now. Things are going to get worse. A lot worse. The Antichrist is going to take over the world, and the world will be spiritually be in darkness for 7 years. At the end of 7 years of tribulation, Jesus is going to come back again, the second coming. At that time He will bring an army with him, and the Antichrist will be defeated, and Jesus will reign on Earth for 1000 years of peace. That's a lot to think about right now though, when the world is in chaos around you.
